One interesting trend that has happened in MN during the pandemic is that people left urban counties to live in rural counties. (Winona County is considered Urban/Town/Rural Mix).</p> <p>From the available data, I do not believe Winona County is following the increasing population trend for college towns. Actually, it’s quite the opposite. Winona County had the largest decline in population from 2010 to 2021 of all counties in MN. You can see population trends for MN here. And you can see Winona County population trends here. However, with the sudden shifts in migration due to the pandemic, maybe Winona County will gain instead of losing residents.
