

MINNESOTA MARRIAGE REQUIREMENTS

Application can be made at the Winona County Vital Statistics office for a marriage to be performed anywhere in Minnesota. For a marriage planned in another state, application must be made in that state.

Both applicants will apply in person at the Winona County Vital Statistics Office, a valid ID will be viewed and a birth record may be required.

A license is valid for six months.

The fee is \$115.00

The 2001 Minnesota Statutes allow marriage license reduction to \$40.00 for intended parties that have participated in a minimum of 12 hours of premarital counseling. A signed statement dated and notarized on Educator's Letterhead providing the education must be submitted at the time the marriage application is applied for, which would list the intended parties' legal names.

Blood tests are not required in Minnesota.

Each party designates their name on the application effective after marriage.

Either applicant or a designated party may pick up the marriage license.
