



Feedlot Closure Form

Within 60 days of closure, an owner of a feedlot must submit a certified letter to the County Feedlot Officer (or MPCA officer for your region) stating the feedlot or manure storage areas have been closed in accordance with MN Rules 7020.2025. Closure is required for feedlot components unused for one year.

3. Vegetation (grasses, alfalfa, etc) has been planted to reduce soil nitrogen levels.
4. Liquid manure storage area: all liquid manure has been removed and land applied.
5. Liquid manure storage area (clay/earthen liner): all discolored soils have been removed (typically one foot below bottom of liner).
6. Liquid manure storage area (concrete liner): storage liner has been cleaned.
7. Liquid manure storage area: County Feedlot Officer has been notified of closure.
8. Liquid manure storage area: backfilling has been completed.
