for a longer period than 20 consecutive hours and a vehicle moved a distance of less than 500 feet during such period shall for the purpose of this ordinance be deemed to have remained stationary.

Violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$300 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days or both.

A peace officer is hereby authorized to move a vehicle to any public garage or other place of safety at the expense of the driver or owner or other person in charge of the vehicle when the vehicle has been parked or left standing in violation of this ordinance. A vehicle so removed shall be released to the driver or owner or other person in charge of the vehicle only upon the payment of any reasonable charges made for towing and storage.

The Winona County Highway Engineer is hereby empowered and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs in the above described area in accordance with the Minnesota Manual Of Uniform Traffic Control Devices For Streets And Highways."


