WHEREAS, there has been published a Notice to Consider the Enactment of an Ordinance which would prohibit animals in Farmers Community Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, The County Board of Winona County hereby ordains that the Ordinance attached to this Resolution shall become law effective upon the date of its publication.

Animals in Farmer's Community Park

Section 1: No person shall permit his animal to be in Farmers Community Park except as otherwise provided in Sections 2 and 3. Farmers Community Park is that area within the limits of Winona County bounded as follows:

On the West by the right-of-way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company; on the North by County Highway 120; On the East by Warren Township Road 12 running North and South and intersecting said County Highway 120 on the North side; and on the South by the South line of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of said Section Eight (8), Township One Hundred Six (106) North of Range Eight (8), containing 27.50 acres, more or less.

Section 2: Notwithstanding Section 1, seeing-eye dogs, i.e. dogs trained to guide the blind, shall be allowed in Farmers Community Park.

Section 3: Notwithstanding Section 1, animals shall be allowed in Farmers Community Park if authorized by permit. Permits to allow animals in Farmers Community Park shall be obtained by application to the Farmers Community Park Board in accordance with the following procedure:

- a) A person seeking issuance of a permit hereunder shall file an application stating the name and address of the applicant; the name and address of the person, persons, corporation or association sponsoring the activity, if any; the day and hours for which the permit is desired; and any other information reasonably necessary to make a determination as to whether a permit should be issued hereunder.
- b) Standards for issuance of a permit shall include the following findings:

that the proposed activity or use promotes education, agriculture or business; that the proposed activity or use will not unreasonably interfere with or detract from the general public's enjoyment of the park; that the proposed activity or use will not unreasonably interfere with or detract from the promotion of public health, welfare, safety and recreation; and that the proposed activity will not entail extraordinary or burdensome expense or law enforcement operation by the Farmers Community Park Board.
- c) A Permittee is bound by all park rules and regulations and applicable ordinances fully as though the same were inserted in any permit.
- d) An applicant for a permit may be required to submit evidence of liability insurance covering injuries to members of the general

public arising out of such permitted activities in such amounts as may from time to time be determined prior to commencement of any activity or the issuance of any permit.

- e) The Farmers Community Park Board shall have the authority to revoke a permit upon finding a violation of any rule or ordinance or upon good cause shown.

Section 4: Violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$700 or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days or both.

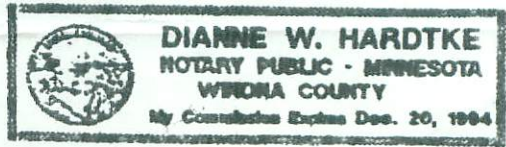
